

Rural Municipality of Chesterfield No. 261

BYLAW NO. 5-2026

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Chesterfield No. 261 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:
 - a) "Public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act.
 - b) "vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*.
2. No person shall operate a vehicle with a vehicle weight greater than ten tonnes at a speed greater than 70 kilometers per hour on any public highway in the municipality.
3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected throughout the municipality.
4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
5. Bylaw No. 2/2009 is hereby repealed.
6. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on 14 day of April, 2026.
